Selection of Candidate to Fill Board Vacancy

He remarked all candidates were very well qualified, and that the board's decision was a difficult one. Mr. Steinert was appointed to fill the vacant position for a 2-year term. The board will meet on November 2nd to administer oaths of office and reorganize.

In addition approval was given for a part-time technology support position.

Policy Revision

Revisions recommended to Policy IKC, Class Rankings/Grade Point Averages were further reviewed and discussed. The revisions pertain to weighted grading and class ranking. The board will continue review of the policy at their November meeting.

Other Items

Financial reports for September, including the cash flow report were reviewed and approved and minutes of the previous meeting were approved. One Requisition was approved; to Motorola for purchase of a radio in the amount of \$1,600. Following discussion and consideration a request to compensate teachers for additional minutes included in the school day was not approved.
