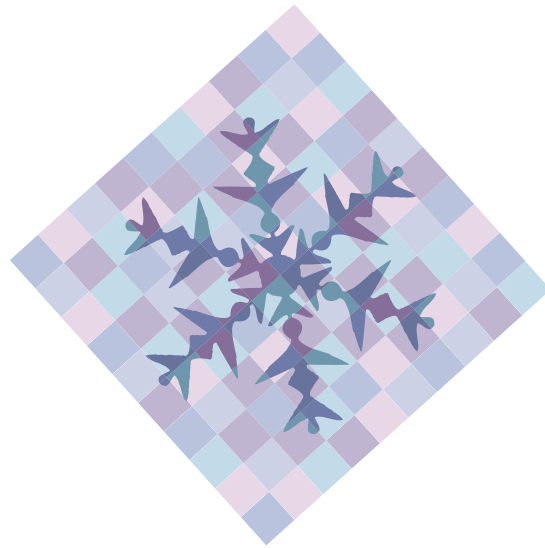

BOARD HIGHLIGHTS

The Board combined their November and December meetings due holiday breaks. A special meeting was held on December 13th for certification of the mill levy and to consider other items which included approval of an out-of-district student enrollment, approval of declaring a bus surplus, and employment items. A resignation from cafeteria employee, Tammy Schnoor was approved with the board's appreciation for Mrs. Schnoor's service. Employment of substitute teacher, Juana Martinez, substitute custodian, Damian Carlson and an increase in hours for part-time teacher, Nikki Pepper for the remainder of the current year were approved.

January 24 meeting:

2009-10 Financial Audit

The report on the district audit, completed by Wall, Smith, Bateman and Associates was presented by Mrs. Willschau and Mrs. Reynolds. The auditors reported finding no concerns or problems, with the exception of a common issue for small districts with internal control. Mrs. Willschau stated the district's fund balance is adequate; a very important factor with current financial conditions. Board members asked about guidance relating to internal control, and gave their approval to the audit.

2010-11 Final Budget

Superintendent, Lauren Sheldrake reviewed changes in the previously approved preliminary budget and answered questions. Adjustments were made as information on funding was finalized. The board approved the final 2010-11 budget, which has a general fund appropriation of \$4,478,757 and a total appropriation of \$6,267,797.

Employment

Junior High Baseball Coach, Keith Brown's resignation was accepted. Employment of substitute teachers Samantha Schoeberl, Cimarrona Kelley and Andrea Bartunek was approved along with extra duty pay agreements for coaches Vicente Barbosa, Gates Shaklee, Jason McFarland and volunteer Emily Pfannenstiel.

Requisition

A requisition was approved to Handwriting Without Tears in the amount of \$2,012.13. Mrs. Kelso explained the materials will add to those purchased last year for kindergarten, and will help provide consistency in handwriting instruction across grade levels.

Demolition Project Bids

The board reviewed bids received for the old building demolition project; approval of a bid was tabled for additional information and further review.

Other Items

Financial reports for December, including the cash flow report were reviewed and approved and minutes of the previous meetings were approved. Out-of-district student enrollment requests were approved as were two student work-study requests.

Discussion Items

Items discussed included options for organizing and storing student records, and the upcoming CASB Winter Legislative Conference.

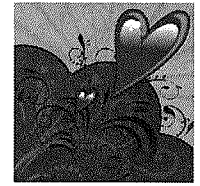
