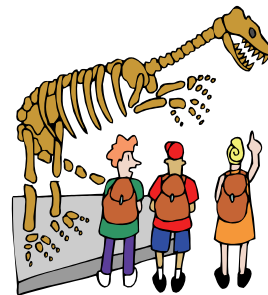

2011-12 Academic Calendar Approved

The school calendar for the upcoming school year was approved. First and last day of classes will be August 25, 2011 and May 24, 2012. Christmas break will be December 19 through 30; spring break will be March 19-23. The new calendar will be posted on the school website.

Search Process for Administrator Position Set

With input from staff, administration and community members present the Board determined the process for filling administrative vacancies for next year. A committee will be formed to review applications for a combined Superintendent/Secondary Principal position. The committee will consist of board members, administration, and representatives from faculty, non-certified staff and the District Accountability Committee. A time-line was established with interviews to take place the second week of May.

Employment

The resignation of High School Wrestling Coach, Travis Garoutte was accepted, with the Board's appreciation for Mr. Garoutte's service. Teacher contracts for the 2011-12 school year were approved, approval of the contract for AD/PE Teacher was tabled and non-renewal of the temporary grant funded position for the Gifted/Talented Teacher was approved. Employment of non-certified employees was approved with the exception of two paraprofessional positions.

Requisitions

The following requisitions were approved: Smith World Travel for FBLA National Leadership Conference, RMS Utilities for sewer line replacement, Simplex Grinnell for the fire alarm system maintenance agreement, RGI-Ace Electric for electrical work, Soft Choice for annual licensing fee, Apple for I-Pads and Pueblo City Schools for Sargent's allocation for Pueblo Youth Services Center.

Transfer of District Health Insurance Coverage Approved

The Board gave their approval to the transfer of the district health insurance coverage from the San Luis Valley Combined Educators plan to the BEST-CASB plan effective June 1, 2011. Coverage for staff members will be basically the same as the current policy.

Other Items

Financial reports for March, including the cash flow report were reviewed and approved and minutes of the previous meetings were approved. Preliminary budget reduction recommendations were discussed and tabled for future action. The board will hold a second budget work session, anticipating additional funding information to be available.

Discussion Items

The board reviewed and discussed information on enrollment trends.

Next Meeting:

The next regular meeting of the board will be May 23, 2011 at 7:00 p.m. In addition, a work session will be held on May 16th for budget planning and discussion.
