## Employment

Mr. Philip Compton's contract for the position of Superintendent/Secondary Principal was approved. The start date for Mr. Compton will be the first week in July. In addition, a contract for Joe Garcia, PE Teacher/Activities Director was approved; employment of Substitute Teacher, Malisa Rytting was approved as were extra duty pay agreements for summer open gym supervision and coaching positions. The resignations of Rhyon Hacsí, Secondary Secretary and Carol Keith, Food Service Director were accepted with gratitude for the service provided by these individuals.

## District Accountability Committee - New Members

New members on the District Accountability Committee were approved. They include Rod Clayton, Alicia Deacon, Lonnie Gillespie, Arthur Holland, Mike Patterson and Nicole Rockey. The committee meets bi-monthly during the school year.

## Requisitions

The following requisitions were approved: Comfort Zone Insulation \$5,674 for insulation for staff housing; Computer Information Concepts \$5,478 for the annual agreement; Northwest Evaluation \$7,092.50 for MAP license renewal; National Literacy Coalition \$2,089.50 for "Every Child A Writer" (REAP funds); and to McGee Company, \$17,291.23 for an alignment machine.

## Vehicle Declared Surplus

The district's 1994 Oldsmobile Cutlass Ceria was declared as surplus. An advertisement requesting sealed bids will be posted, and the vehicle sold.

## Meal Price Increase Approved

The Board gave their approval for a \$0.25 increase in breakfast and lunch prices for the 2011-12 school year. Prices for breakfast for all students will be \$1.60; elementary lunch, \$2.10; secondary lunch \$2.45. The last time a price increase was approved was for the 2008-09 school year.

## Other Items

Financial reports for April, including the cash flow report were reviewed and approved and minutes of the previous meeting were approved. A revision to policy AE-R District Accountability Committee Bylaws was approved. The revision adjusts the number of voting members needed to constitute a quorum.

## Discussion Items

The Preliminary 2011-12 Budget was discussed; the proposed budget is available in the district office for review, and will be considered for approval at the June board meeting, date and time noted below. Interested taxpayers may inspect the proposed budget and file or register any objections at any time prior to the final adoption of the budget. Other discussion items included the 2011-12 academic schedule and weighting of grades for college courses.
